

## HADDON (CHN) BLUE GREY SLATE ROOF TILES

A strong, durable slate with excellent reliability and performance in the UK and European markets. It naturally splits from the block to give a relatively flat smooth fine grain surface with slight longitudinal texture. It is free of any reactive mineral inclusions and conforms to the requirements of BS EN 12326 with a W1 T1 and S1 specification. ### Suitability & Use

Haddon (CHN) slates were tested at the stringent testing laboratories of North Wales with excellent results in all categories having great strength characteristics to meet the demands imposed by the most severe of climatic conditions, this requires the quarry and slates to continually meet the exacting quality criteria and production testing procedures to ensure consistent quality to meet BS EN standards.

Haddon (CHN) are sourced from one quarry and the production process is handled by one site to ensure only slates from this location are supplied to us. We have worked with the quarry to ensure the slates are professionally



palletised and presented to give maximum protection during transit, shrink wrapped and labelled with BS EN Certification and pallet codes to ensure product traceability.

Haddon (CHN) a natural product defined by its unique colour and surface characteristics, smooth fine grained natural slate that can have slight variations in shading and texture, more visible in direct sunlight, overtime all slates weather based upon the climatic conditions of the site location.
